Our Carnivore Conflict and Conservation was written to give you a clear understanding of how large carnivores live, why conflict with people happens, and what can be done to prevent it. While our focus is primarily on African species such as lions, leopards, cheetahs, hyaenas, and wild dogs, the principles shared here apply across many landscapes where people and predators interact.

Whether you are a guide, landowner, conservation volunteer, student, or simply passionate about wildlife, this course will help you think more deeply about predator ecology, ethical conservation, and the shared responsibilities we hold. You will explore real-world challenges, modern solutions, and the changing role of people in protecting carnivores without sacrificing community well-being.

By the end of this course, you'll have a clearer understanding of how to reduce conflict, support conservation, and contribute to a future where people and predators can share the land more safely and respectfully.
